We are thrilled to announce that our final roadshow reports have been published and are now available on our website. A heartfelt thank you to everyone who attended and contributed to these events!


We're already busy planning our future events, so be sure to check out our 'Upcoming Events' section to book your spot. Remember, all events are **free** and open to any women living in Scotland.




